EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Asian Development Bank (ADB), Agence Française de Développement (AFD) and Government of Bangladesh (GOB) supported Improving Urban Governance and Infrastructure Program (IUGIP) under the results-based lending (RBL) modality which aim to improve infrastructure facilities such as drains, roads, streetlights, low-income neighborhoods improvements (footpaths, drains, streetlights, tube wells, dust bins and community toilets), and market centers and parks in selected 88 pourashavas. ADB has supported enhancements in pourashavas' service delivery capacity and effectiveness through a series of sector projects to reduce regional disparities and encourage local economic development: the Urban Governance and Infrastructure Improvement Project (UGIIP) in 2002, the second UGIIP (2008), and the third UGIIP (2014).

Under IUGIP, out of these 88 Pourashavas, 63 are classified by LGED as 'mainstream' pourashavas' and 25 are under Operation and Maintenance (O & M). 63 Pourashavas were selected for improvement of infrastructure facilities such as construction and improvement work of drains, roads, streetlights, low-income neighborhoods improvements (footpaths, drains, streetlights, tube wells, dust bins and community toilets), market centers and parks under IUGIP. These pourashavas were not selected before for Urban Governance Infrastructure Improvement Projects (UGIIP-i, UGIIP--ii & UGIIP- iii) of LGED. LGED has been considering these pourashavas as mainstream pourashavas. To keep up the continuation of the solid waste management works (SWM) at the pourashava level the completed subprojects related to SWM under UGIIP-iii further required operation and maintenance (O & M). 25 Pourashavas of this type are included in IUGIP and these Pourashavas are considered for O & M interventions. The project takes a holistic and integrated approach to urban development under the results lending modality. IUGIP is being implemented by Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) under the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives (MLGRDC). LGED is the Executing Agency and Pourashavas are the implementing agencies of the Program. IUGIP will follow the Environment and Social Management Framework (ESMF) aligned with the National Laws and ADB safeguards Policy principles for resettlement and Indigenous Peoples/Tribes, Minor races, Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC). IUGIP has commenced on June 2023 and consultants were hired by the PMU through PMDSC with approval from ADB who started their responsibilities and activities since January 2024. This Semiannual Social Safeguard Monitoring Report (SSMR) provides an overview of the Improving Urban Governance and Infrastructure Program (IUGIP) compliance status against the applicable standards, laws and regulations for social safeguard for the period of October 2023 to March 2024. Social screening of the subprojects done using the Involuntary Resettlement Screening Checklist (Appendix 4, ESMF). The Involuntary Resettlement Screening Checklist for TMRESC has been appended as Appendix 2 in this report.

A Program Safeguard System Assessment (PSSA) was conducted and reported on March 2023. During preparation of PSSA due diligence was conducted in five sample Pourashavas to examine RBL program activities. Objectives of the PSSA was to identify potential safeguard impacts and risks and to assess the program systems. The PSSA assessed the existing laws, regulations, rules and guidelines for managing and mitigation of environment and social impacts of the RBL program. The PSSA identified gaps between ADB safeguard Policy Principles and program safeguard systems and recommended programs actions to improve program safeguards and the safeguard action plans.

IUGIP has prepared an Environment and Social Management Framework (ESMF) and submitted to ADB. The key objective of the ESMF is to establish clear procedures and methodologies for environmental and social planning, review, approval and implementation of components to be financed under this Program. The monitoring activities of social safeguard team includes implementation of the ESMF specially for involuntary resettlement and

TMRESC/indigenous peoples safeguard.

The Social Safeguard Team of PMDSC consists of Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist and four Junior Resettlement/Social Safeguard Specialists. The program spans across eight administrative divisions in Bangladesh, with the project *pourashavas* located in each of these divisions. Each Junior Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialists is responsible for assessing social safeguard impacts and monitoring of social safeguard activities related to program works in two Divisions under the coordination of Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist. The Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist oversees the performance of four Junior Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialists, ensure social safeguards compliance at pourashavas/field-level, prepares various periodical social safeguard monitoring reports and implements resettlement plan/ DDRs. Additionally, a Senior Assistant Engineer from PMU serves as the focal person for Resettlement/ Social Safeguard issues.

After design completion, the social safeguards team of PMDSC have visited the subproject sites to assess social safeguards impacts of the project interventions following the prescribed social screening format. During the reporting period, the social safeguard team visited 105 packages across 41 Pourashavas. The list of the packages screened by social safeguard team is provided Appendix 1. The team used the 'Involuntary Resettlement Screening Form' (Appendix-2) from the ESMF to identify potential involuntary resettlement impacts and risks. Social safeguard impacts were assessed based on physical observations of the schemes, discussions with community members during public consultations, and interactions with stakeholders, community leaders, and other stakeholders. If the screening identifies involuntary resettlement impacts, LGED will prepare a resettlement plan. For those without involuntary resettlement impacts, due diligence Reports (DDRs) are prepared. During the impact assessments, the social safeguard team conducted 18 public consultations, involving a total of 279 participants, of which 221 were male and 58 were female.

Due Diligence Reports (DDR) were prepared following the assessment of subprojects by the Social Safeguard Teams and submitted to the Team Leader. A draft copy of the DDR has been submitted to Focal Person of Social safeguard designated from PMU. The Focal Person then n reviewed the DDR and take action to send it to the ADB for their concurrence. During the reporting period, the Resettlement Team visited 35 Pourashavas and prepared 105 DDRs. Out of the 35 visited Pourashavas, 34 were visited during PPTA (Project Preparatory Technical Assistance) period of IUGIP. Out of the 105 submitted DDRs 104 DDRs are submitted to PMU during PPTA period. The Resettlement Specialists of PMDSC has been engaged since January 2024.

IUGIP established the grievance redress mechanism (GRM) to voice and resolve social and environmental concerns linked to the project and ensure greater accountability of the project authorities towards all affected persons. The GRM addressed aggrieved persons concerns and complaints promptly using an understandable and transparent process that is gender responsive, culturally appropriate, and readily accessible to all segments of the affected people at no costs and without retribution. A guideline on procedures to operate GRM will be prepared in Bengali and will be mailed to all Pourashavas through PMU. The program is still in its very initial stage and Contract Agreement with contractors was furnished for 74 packages and contractor has started their works in 48 packages. The Program beneficiaries and communities have not experienced any construction-related issues. No complaint has been registered by the GRCs during the reporting period.

Capacity building training on environmental and social safeguard policies will be arranged at PMU, PIUs and subproject construction sites. The preparation and implementation of safeguard planning and monitoring instruments will also be discussed in the training program. The guideline on Capacity Building Training for Safeguard Compliance outlined in the ESMF (para 100 – 102).

The training course on gender, environmental and social safeguard, contract management, climate change and quality control of Infrastructure for Contractors and Project Pourashava Engineers is part of the overall training courses designed and implemented aims to capacitate the PMU and PIUs of the program. A capacity -building/ training was arranged during the reporting period at Cumilla Regional Training Centre. 39 participants attended the training from 9 Pourashavas.

I. INTRODUCTION

A. Project Background

- 1. The Asian Development Bank (ADB), Agence Française de Développement (AFD) and Government of Bangladesh (GOB) supported Improving Urban Governance and Infrastructure Program (IUGIP) under the results-based lending (RBL) modality which aim to improve infrastructure facilities such as drains, roads, streetlights, low-income neighborhoods improvements (footpaths, drains, streetlights, tube wells, dust bins and community toilets), and market centers and parks in selected 88 pourashavas. ADB has supported enhancements in pourashavas' service delivery capacity and effectiveness through a series of sector projects to reduce regional disparities and encourage local economic development: the Urban Governance and Infrastructure Improvement Project (UGIIP) in 2002, the second UGIIP (2008), and the third UGIIP (2014).
- 2. The RBL program's impacts will be: urban poverty reduced and living conditions improved. The outcome will be: improved municipal services and governance in target pourashavas in terms of increased holding tax collection efficiency (DLI 1) and improved livability (non-DLI). Selected DLIs, identified under each output described below, will create incentives to achieve the program's expected outcome. The program includes the following outputs: Output 1: Institutional capacity for inclusive municipal governance strengthened; and Output 2: Municipal infrastructure improved in quality, access, resilience, and gender responsiveness.
- 3. The following are the disbursement-linked indicators output-wise:

4. This Semiannual Social Safeguard Monitoring Report provides an overview of the Improving Urban Governance and Infrastructure Program (IUGIP) compliance status against the applicable standards, laws and regulations for Social Safeguard for the period of October 2023 to March 2024. IUGIP has prepared an Environment and Social Management Framework (ESMF) and submitted to ADB. This guiding framework is prepared to ensure that subsequent project activities have a common understanding of the environmental and social issues involved, and a harmonized approach to handling these issues is followed. The ESMF is being used as guidelines to address the safeguard compliances throughout the project area. This social safeguard monitoring report (SSMR) includes the activities during monitoring of implementation ESMF, specifically for involuntary resettlement and Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC) safeguards. This SSMR has been finalized based on the site visits under different packages of Pourashavas, it includes discussion with the stakeholders and community people.

B. Objectives of this SSMR

5. As a result-based loan, LGED has to ensure that environmental and social impacts are adequately addressed. The main objective of social monitoring is to: (i) provide an assessment on the progress of social safeguard compliances of the program during the reporting period. This SSMR aims to (ii) provide update/status on the implementation of the ESMF and the safeguards policy action. The key safeguards implementation plans will be the social safeguards documents prepared for the subprojects where involuntary resettlement impacts are triggered; (iii) verify subproject's compliance with social safeguards measures and its progress; (iv) document any issues and concerns in the covered period; and (v) recommend/come up with follow up action to ensure social safeguards compliance.

C. Scope of the SSMR

- 6. Social safeguard monitoring is an integral component under RBL program. The program will follow the procedures and requirements provided in the Environmental and Social Management Framework (ESMF). At the PMU level, the Social Safeguard Team has developed a methodology following the guidelines of ESMF and appendix 5 of PID for social safeguards monitoring. The Social safeguard experts have been verifying the safeguard compliances with the safeguard measures and its progress toward intended outcomes.
- 7. Social Monitoring Checklist has been prepared to determine the social safeguard compliances during construction period. It is also to measure the progress/achievement of the indicators from the baseline data generated by the due diligence and social screening exercises at the subproject level. These indicators are essential for monitoring compliance with safeguards during project implementation, with a particular emphasis on involuntary resettlement and TMRESC safeguards. PMDSC consolidates the progress reports and accordingly prepared this SSMR for the RBL program.
- 8. This semiannual social safeguard monitoring reports are prepared semi-annually following the reporting period October March and April to September. The program commenced on 1 July of 2023, and the loan became effective on 12 October 2023. This SSMR has been prepared for the period of October 2023 to March 2024.

9. The SSMR aims to:

- (i) Establish and maintain procedures to monitor the progress of implementation of safeguard policies/ plans;
- (ii) Capture any adverse impact in terms of involuntary resettlement impact (income

- loss due to loss of access during construction, structure loss, etc.) or TMRESC-related impacts during construction works.
- (iii) Provide information on necessary safeguard methods adopted to avoid, reduce, minimize, mitigate or compensate any adverse impact due to project work.
- (iv) Identify mitigation measures and any residual negative impacts that cannot be avoided,
- (v) Describe process undertaken during project design and to disclose project activities to stakeholders and beneficiaries of the subproject.
- (vi) Describe the subprojects Grievance Redress Mechanism for resolving complaints and its resolution.
- (vii) Monitor and provide recommendation and other follow up actions to ensure progress toward the desired outcome.



II. SOCIAL SAFEGUARD IMPACT ASSESSMENT

- 11. Up to March 2024, the **s**ocial safeguard consultants of IUGIP visited 105 packages at 41 Pourashavas. The consultants screened the social safeguard impacts at the subproject areas. The screening and social assessment process was carried in each scheme using the involuntary resettlement screening checklist provided in the Appendix 4 of the ESMF. From social screening, it was determined whether preparation of Resettlement Plan or Due Diligence report will be required for the packages. As of the reporting period, no project impact assessment has been conducted in any TMRESC(IP) inhabited areas.
- 12. The Social Safeguard Team has visited the sites upon design completion of the proposed schemes under 105 packages in 41 *Pourashavas* during the reporting period. PMDSC safeguard team along with respective PIUs undertook due diligence of involuntary resettlement impacts in each subproject area and conducted screening of the subprojects using the involuntary resettlement screening checklist provided in the Appendix 4 of the ESMF (Appendix- 2 of this SMR). The team assessed the requirements for preparing the Due Diligence Report. The Social Safeguard Team conducted public consultations and stakeholder meetings as well.
- 13. Involuntary Resettlement Safeguards. During social screening and due diligence, potential impacts are found mainly related to construction and are short term, localized and can be mitigated with effective construction practices and measures. Roads, footpath and drain works will be carried out along the existing road rights of way within the government lands. Hence, no additional land will be required. Involuntary Resettlement (IR) impacts are not assessed at this stage. However, if any future and/or unanticipated impacts identified during construction involving income loss or displacement the due diligence will be converted to resettlement plan (the list of design completed packages, status of tender award and progress of work has been appended at Appendix No 1).
- 14. Throughout the implementation period, if any potential resettlement impacts are monitored, necessary mitigation measures will be taken to avoid or mitigate the impacts. Therefore, any potential impact of the subprojects will be fully avoided, and correspondingly, no issues relating to involuntary resettlement will occur during implementation of the subproject. Although, these roads and drainage schemes will not have any involuntary resettlement impact but, the construction/improvement of the subproject may cause only minor and temporary disturbances limited to dust and noise, movement of people etc., which are limited to the construction period only, and could easily be mitigated. Damages/unanticipated losses caused due to construction works will be eligible for compensation following ESMF (Para 77, approved ESMF).
- 15. Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities/Indigenous Peoples Safeguards According to Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics 2011 census data, there are Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC) less than 1% (3,693) of total population 1,458,990 in in 37 of 63 *pourashavas* under RBL program. But in two Pourashavas Banskhali and Naohata, TMRESC people are 3.91% (1444 persons) and 1.57% (897) respectively. However, the TMRESC population is scattered around the *Pourashavas* (does not stay in cohesive TMRES communities or groups) in all most all the *pourashavas* and is well assimilated in urban society. Schemes in the two Pourashavas were visited by the consultants of PMDSC and potential impacts were assessed, public consultations with the TMRESC people were organized. No adverse impacts for TMRESC people were identified. Resettlement Specialist, PMDSC joined IUGIP after submission of this SSMR. He will conduct further visits to these two Pourashavas for intensive observation of IP issues.

- 16. Bangladesh is a country of cultural and ethnic diversity, with over 54 Indigenous/TMRESC Peoples speaking at least 35 languages, along with the majority Bengali population. According to the 2022 census, the country's TMRESC population numbers approximately 1,650,478 which represents 1% of the total population. Chakma, Garo, Manipuri, Marma, Munda, Oraon, Santal, Khasi, Kuki, Tripura, Mro, Hajong and Rakhain are some of the well-known TMRES communities in Bangladesh. TMRESC peoples in Bangladesh call themselves 'Adivasi'.
- 17. The following table shows the TMRESC population in Bangladesh by Divisions. Pourashavas under the IUGIP (Program) are in all of the eight Divisions of Bangladesh.

- 18. The table describes the total TMRESC population and percentage by Division. It has been revealed from the table that out of the total population in Bangladesh, the TMRESC accounts for 1%. Out of the eight Divisions TMRESC population is less than 1% in five Divisions and slightly higher in two Divisions. The highest percentage (2.99%) of TMRESC people are living in Chattogram Division. The program PSSA describes out of 86 Pourashavas in 37 Pourashavas under the RBL program the TMRESC constitutes less than 1% of total population but at two pourashavas TMRESC population is 3.91% and 1.57% at Banskhali and Naohata respectively. In case of males and females of TMRESC, the ratio is 1.01% and 0.99% respectively.
- 19. The program will prepare TMRESC Plan, if required, following the policy principles outlined in ESMF. The safeguard document will contain a specific action plan for beneficial impacts of TMRESC.
- 20. The project is assessed category B for indigenous people/ Tribes, Minor Races, Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC). However, the TMRESC population is scattered around the Pourashavas in almost all the Pourashavas and are well assimilated in urban society.
- 21. In case of involuntary resettlement and TMRESC impacts are assessed, the program will prepare resettlement plan and TMRESC Plan following the policy principles outlined in ESMF.

A. Status of Social Safeguard Program Action Plan (PAP)

22. The following program actions are suggested to mitigate the identified risks and strengthen the capacity of LGED to implement the RBL program:

B. Program Safeguard Systems Assessment (PSSA)

23. A Program safeguard Systems Assessment (PSSA) was conducted for the program. Based on the ESMF, at that time, due diligence was done in five program towns (Chowmohani, Rouzan, Araihazar, Naohata and Keshabpur). During the assessment, the team physically

visited the Pourashavas and no IR potential impacts of project construction works related to involuntary resettlement were identified. For Chowmohani, a proper due diligence will be undertaken and accordingly, appropriate social safeguards documents will be prepared and/or updated. Several stakeholder consultation meetings were conducted with the Mayors, Panel Mayors, Pourashava Councilors and Secretaries, TLCC and WC Members, concerned Engineers and Officials of the Pourashavas. Public consultations in these Pourashavas were also conducted to exchange views with the beneficiaries of the program, disclosed project objectives and activities and also assess the potential impacts of the program.

- 24. It has been reported in the PSSA that people from Tribes, Minor Races. Ethnic Sects and Communities (TMRESC) are less than 1% of total population. But at Naohata and Banskhali (out of the sample Pourashavas) people of TMRES Communities are 1.57% and 3.91% of total population of the Pourashavas respectively. It was reported in the PSSA report that, "However, the TMRESC population is scattered around the Pourashavas (does not stay in cohesive TMRES communities or groups) in all most all the pourashavas and is well assimilated in urban society."
- 25. The social safeguard team visited the subproject areas and conducted meeting with the community people and separately with TMRESC people. No significant adverse impact was reported neither from mainstream people nor from TMRESC people. Some impacts found which were short term and mitigated with good construction practices. The beneficial impacts on community people are recorded from the feedbacks from participants. It was reported from the project beneficiaries that after completion of the road travelling and carrying goods will be comfortable, easier, time saving and also economic.
- 26. The Resettlement/Social safeguard Specialist plans to visit the three Pourashavas (Banskhali, Naohata and Chowmohani) along with Environmental Specialist, Jr. Resettlement Specialists to engage with the community people. The program has been delayed due to some unavoidable reasons and devastating floods in the concern areas.

C. Public Consultation

Public consultations with the community people at different subprojects of Pourashavas were undertaken to exchange views on subproject implementation and to disclose project activities. The public consultations are conducted with prior notice, ensuring wide reach and accessibility for individuals from various sectors. At project implementing unit, (PIU), contractors with the supervision of the Pourashavas are implementing construction works of road, drain and streetlight under different schemes. Participants of these consultations are community people, Pourashava officials, Councilors, TLCC, WC members, People's Representatives, contractors or their representatives, local leaders, businessmen, religious leaders, journalists, other government officials and different stakeholders since subproject preparation to date who participated at different stages of the project activities. The consultations/meetings were conducted at subproject sites and Pourashava offices. addition, hotspot/information discussion were held in the project site as a part of information dissemination about the upcoming subproject. Details on consultation/meetings are described in the following paragraph and in Table No. 2. IUGIP arranged 18 public consultations in 7 Pouroshavas during the reporting period. A total of 279 participants (male-221 and female-58) participated in the meetings. The major objective of such consultations was to exchange views on project objectives and activities, assessing potential impacts of project activities and to disclose project mitigation plan of potential adverse impacts. In these meetings different issues related to project activities, problems/constraints and project methods to address the constrains are identified and discussed. Consultation is a continuous process which requires holding meetings with the project beneficiaries from the very beginning of the project preparation to the stages of implementation and monitoring of the project activities. The Grievance Redress Mechanism of the project has been discussed in these meetings. Formation of grievance redress committees (GRCs), GRC functions, types of complaints, procedures of submitting complaints, different stages of GRM etc. were discussed at the meetings. Feedback from the participants are recorded and facilitators (Resettlement Team) responded on the concerns of participants. List of public consultations held during the reporting period are showed in the following table and concerns raised by the participants are discussed in the following paragraph. The community people, local leaders, project beneficiaries along with subprojects and other stakeholders attended the public consultation. This interactive approach will continue during the implementation of the subproject. The findings of the above consultations revealed lots of positive impacts despite a few temporary impacts/concerns limited to construction period only, which have the scope of mitigation.

- 28. The following topics were discussed in public consultations. The topics may be summarized as follows:
 - (i) Briefing on Project background and objectives in short.
 - (ii) Background of subproject selection and scope of the construction works.
 - (iii) Potential benefits from the subproject expected by the program.
 - (iv) Potential problems may occur during construction and their level. How those will be avoided or mitigated by the PIU and contractors.
 - (v) Project policy on social safeguard, responsibility of PMU, PIU and contractors to address the social safeguard compliances.
 - (vi) Project Grievance Redress Mechanism in details was discussed. The focal person of GRC in PIU, contractors' responsibility in GRM, and process of grievance hearing was discussed.

- (vii) Copy of Grievance Registration Form was shown to the attendance.
- (viii) Suggestions from the beneficiaries for the betterment of the subproject invited.
- (ix) Requirement of acquisition for the subproject was discussed.
- (x) Responsibility of beneficiaries in well maintenance of the subproject discussed
- 29. During the public participation, the participants exchanged their views with the facilitators. The participants expressed their concerns too. Concerns of the participants of the public consultations are mostly common. Concerns of the participants and responses of facilitators of the public consultations are mentioned in the following table.

- 31. Since mobilization at the initial stage, the PPMDSC and Social Safeguard Specialists have been working on to finalize the design and preparation of required social safeguard documents/ reports for the identified subproject as well as conducting of feasibility study and worked closely with PMDSC during preparation of final design for the new subprojects selected. During the reporting period, the safeguard consultants subsequently also prepared number of social safeguard reports for subprojects with the design-completed schemes.
- 32. A list of schemes under different Packages visited and impact assessed by the. Social Safeguard Team of PPMDSC is appended at Appendix- 1. The roads and drains will be constructed within the rights of way (ROW) of Pourashava roads. Due diligence was conducted to assess the schemes. The assessment indicates that there will be no land acquisition or physical displacement or permanent economic displacement of any individual, household or community.

III. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS AND CAPACITY BUILDING

A. Institutional Arrangement for social safeguard

- 33. The Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives (MLGRDC) acting through its Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) is the Executing Agency. At the LGED, PMU has been established and this PMU is being supported by the consultants. At the *Pourashava* level, district level team of LGED (PIU) will implement the program related construction works. As part of current RBL program implementation, the PSSA has recommended as an action point for recruitment of one Environmental Safeguard Specialist and one Social Safeguard Specialist at the PMU level. Both safeguard specialists are reporting to the Project Director and together and formed the safeguard cell. At PIU level, one officer of Assistant Engineer rank is designated as safeguard focal person, who will ensure EMP and Resettlement Plan implementation. Project Management, Design and Supervision Consultants (PPMDSC) are engaged to work closely with and advise the PMU and PIUs.
- 34. Social Safeguard Team of PPMDSC constitutes of Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist and four Junior Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialists. Responsibility of Social Safeguard Specialist is to determine requirement of preparation of RP or DDR and to prepare them according to requirement in compliance with ADB SPS 2009 and Regulations of GoB. The team has been confirming inclusion of DDRs in bidding documents and civil work contracts, has been monitoring the implementation and disclosing of social safeguard (DDRs)


Plans and Grievance Redress Mechanism. The social safeguard team consolidates monthly social safeguard from PIUs and to prepare and disclose in Semi-annual and Annual Social Safeguard reports upon approval of ADB. PMU Safeguard Cell will assess training need and coordinate training activities for PMU and PIUs officials, Contractors.

35. Municipal Engineers are deployed by PPMDSC at all Pourashavas selected for the program. They assist Pourashavas in preparation of Development Plan (PDP) meeting all necessary requirements including social and environmental safeguard issues followed at Pourashava level.

B. Capacity Building and Training for Social Safeguards Compliance

- 36. Capacity building training on environmental and social safeguard policies will be arranged at PMU, PIUs and subproject construction sites. The preparation and implementation of safeguard planning and Monitoring instruments will also be discussed in the training program. A guideline on Capacity Building Training for Safeguard Compliance outlined in the ESMF (para 100 102).
- 37. The Training course on 'Gender, Environmental and Social Safeguard, Contract Management, Climate Change & quality Control of Infrastructure for Contractors and Project Pourashava Engineers' constitutes a part of the overall training courses designed and implemented in line with the Objectives of the Capacity Development of MDS under Improving Urban Governance and Infrastructure Project, Local Government Engineering Department. A

Capacity Capacity building training was arranged during the reporting period at Cumilla Regional Training Centre. 39 participants attended the Course from 9 Pourashavas.

JR. Resettlement Specialist, PMDSC, IUGIP was present as a Resource person in the program.

- 38. The overall objective of this training course is to enhance knowledge, skill and positive change of attitude specially of technical officials of Pourashavas, Contractors and IUGIP officials in order to fulfilling the criterion of the development partners' requirements efficiently.
- 39. The following table shows the name of the Pourashavas, category and number of participants attended in the daylong training.

Note: In all,24 technical officials and 15 Contractors were imparted training. The number of trainees invited was 43 and attended 39. Percentage of attendance was **90.70%** and achieved trainee-days was **39**.

- 40. The Resettlement/ Social safeguard Specialist joined the Program on 1 July, 2024. So, one Junior Resettlement/ Social safeguard Specialist attended the training program. The Social Safeguard policy of the program was discussed. To address the project social safeguard compliances in project works responsibility of concerned persons were discussed. The preparation of Social Safeguard Periodical Reports and advised to mitigate or avoid adverse impacts were also discussed.
- 41. Social safeguard Capacity Building Training will be arranged for PMU Officials, PIU Officials of 63 Pourashavas and for contractors awarded contracts for construction works. Project Safeguard Policies (Environment and Social) as outlined in ADB SPS 2009, EMP and Implementation of Resettlement Plan will be discussed in the training. The project GRM, social safeguard monitoring requirements and mitigation measures will be oriented during the training program. As a part of capacity building during the implementation of IUGIP RBL Program, training program will be conducted at PMU, PIUs and subprojects construction sites.
- 42. Preparation of training plan and training materials are under process. It is expected that the Capacity Building Training will be conducted in September and October of 2024. Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist, Environmental Specialist are preparing the training material and will conduct the training program. The Jr. Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialists and Jr. Environment Specialists will also be included as trainer. Environment Specialist and Jr. Environment Specialist will train the participants on project environmental safeguard policies. The Project Safeguard policies are being prepared following the ADB Safeguard Policy Statement 2009 and on GoB Safeguard Policy. The training will be arranged on a regular interval. Progress of the capacity building training will be reported to ADB time to time.

IV. GRIEVANCE REDRESS MECHANISM (GRM)

- 43. In order to receive and facilitate the resolution of affected people's concerns, complaints, and grievances concerning the subproject's safeguards performance, IUGIP has established a Grievance Redress Mechanism (GRM) consistent with the ESMF.¹ This GRM will work to address any complaints related to project activities that arise during the implementation of the subproject. The RBL program have both online as well as offline mode to receive the grievances. An aggrieved person can register his/her complaint through telephone, mobile, or email or by writing in the Complaint Registers maintaining in the PIU/Pourashava office and contractor's offices.
- 44. Complaint boxes are installed at all of the PIUs. The safeguard focal person at PMU will ensure the follow-up of the grievance until resolved. The PMU will have a regular review to ensure that all grievances are resolved in time-bound and through a transparent mechanism. The affected person is free to access the country's legal system at any time and at any stage. The affected person also can use the ADB Accountability Mechanism (AM) through directly contacting (in writing) the Complaint Receiving Officer (CRO) at ADB headquarters or the ADB Bangladesh Resident Mission (BRM). The sample of Grievance Registration Form has been appended in Appendix- 4. The Registration Form used in ESMF has been revised following the requirement and the English version of the form annexed in this report. PMU safeguard officer will have the overall responsibility for timely grievance redressal on environmental and social safeguards issues and for registration of grievances, related disclosure, and communication with the suggested party through the PIU designated safeguard focal person.
- 45. The GRCs are using Grievance Redress Registers to maintain the records of complaints and of resolution of complaints. The Grievance Redress Registers recorded summery of the complaints, hearing processes of complaints, GRC decision and opinion of the complainants. A guideline to operate GRM, sample of Grievance Registration Form and model of Grievance Registers will be prepared in Bengali and sent to all of the project Pourashavas for their uses.
- 46. The multi-tier GRM for the project is outlined below. Time-bound schedules of each tier discussed and persons responsible for arranging hearing and redressing the complaints are also identified.
- 47. **1st Level Grievance, Pourashava Level PIU**. The contractors, PIU Safeguard and Gender Focal person can immediately resolve issues on-site or at Pourashava level in consultation with each other with the support of Administrative Officer of Pourashava, designated municipal ward councilor and will be required to do so within 7 days of receipt of a complaint/grievance. Assistance of ward committees (WC) will be sought if required for resolution of the issue, by any one or all of them jointly. The First Level Grievance Redress Committee will be comprised of the following members:
 - a. Chief Executive Officer or Poura Nirbahi Officer
 - b. Executive Engineer, Pourashava/ Safeguard and Gender Focal person
 - c. Administrative Officer, Pourashava (will act as secretary GRC level-1)
 - d. Municipal Ward Councilor (designated)/ WC member
 - e. Medical Officer/Environment Health Safety (EHS Supervisor)/, Contractor
 - f. Affected Person's Representative/ Community or NGO Representative of project Area.
- 48. Some designation of the members of GRC required to be changed in ESMF

- 49. **2nd Level Grievance, Pourashava Level**. All grievances that cannot be redressed within 7 days at Ward level will be brought up to the Second Level Grievance Redress Committee (GRC) headed by the Panel Mayor. Second Level Grievance Redress Committee at Pourashava level will attempt to resolve the grievance /complaint within 15 days. The composition of 2nd level Grievance Redress Committee is as follows:
 - (i) Panel Mayor of the Pourashava
 - (ii) Chief Executive Officer/ Poura Nirbahi Officer (will act as member secretary)
 - (iii) Executive Engineer of the Pourashava
 - (iv) Concerned Councilor of the Pourashava
 - (v) Administrative officer of the Pourashava
 - (vi) One women member/ Reserve women seat councilor
 - (vii) Representative of Affected Person/ TLCC member/ NGO member
- 50. **3rd Level Grievance,** Project Management Unit (PMU): The grievances that are not redressed within 30 days of submission at Pourashava level will be forwarded to the PMU level. Pourashava Level Grievance Redress Committee will refer any unresolved or major issues to the PMU level Grievance Redress Committee, which will be headed by the Project Director and will have Mayor of the Pourashava, Deputy Project Director, Senior Assistant Engineer, Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist, Environment Specialist as Committee Members. The 3rd Level Grievance Redress Committee will resolve the complaints/grievances within 30 days of receiving. The 3rd Level/ PMU level Grievance Redress Committee will comprise of:
 - (i) Project Director,
 - (ii) Mayor of the Pourashava
 - (iii) Deputy Project Director
 - (iv) Senior Assistant Engineer (will act as Member Secretary GRC level-3)
 - (v) Resettlement/ Social Safeguard Specialist
 - (vi) Environmental Specialist
 - (vii) Senior Assistant Engineer / Gender Focal Persons
- 51. (At present (September 2024) position of Mayors and Counselors are abolished. Government deployed Executives for the position of Mayor. So, the Executive are replaced in place of Mayor in GRCs and Representatives of Executive will be replaced in position of Councilor in GRCs)

52. As the reporting period is very initial stage of the project, project development activities still have not started at most of the sub-projects, the project beneficiaries still do not face any problem from construction works. So, no complaint has been registered by the GRCs during the reporting period.

V. FOLLOW UP ACTIONS, RECOMMENDATION AND DISCLOSURE

- 53. In most of the Pourashavas, project implementation works of IUGIP is ongoing. In these sub-projects addressing of social safeguard compliances considered with importance. During preparation of design for the subprojects social safeguard impacts are screened, impacts are assessed to consider the mitigation methodology and to determine requirement of preparation resettlement plan or due diligence report.
- 54. The baseline data are available from Social Screening report, PSSA report and Due Diligence reports. The Social safeguard team are visiting construction works ongoing projects to monitor how the social safeguard compliances are addressed during construction works. During the monitoring, the Assistant Engineer from Pourashava and Monitoring Engineer of PMDSC assist the social safeguard team of PMDSC in monitoring. The monitoring team uses prescribed monitoring checklists.
- 55. The team works on construction work ongoing places, workers shed and meet community people. Monitoring reports are prepared on the basis of this observation too. The data will be used in measuring the changes on social safeguard condition.

A. Mitigation of impacts and GRM management

- 56. IUGIP aims at enhancing urban governance and improving infrastructure sustainability of the targeted Pourashavas using an approach based on integrated and holistic planning. The Project supports the development of key urban infrastructure, focusing on projects that enhance the urban environment, poverty alleviation, gender responsive and economic development. The Project also supports the Government to strengthen Pourashavas management and capacity for effective and sustainable urban development.
- 57. IUGIP has developed a Grievance Redress Mechanism (GRM) to resolve or mitigate complaints of aggrieved persons. As of the end of the reporting period, construction works of only a few schemes have started, so the project beneficiaries do not face any adverse impacts from construction works. The Grievance Redress Committees (GRCs) have not received any complaint from the community people.
- 58. While there are no significant or no IR impacts and impacts are of short term and can easily be mitigated, the project prepares due diligence report. The PSSA reported that roads and drains will be constructed within the rights-of-way (ROW) of Pourashava roads, while improvements in low-income neighborhoods, markets, and parks will take place on Pourashava land. The initial assessment confirmed that no land acquisition, physical displacement, or permanent economic displacement of individuals, households, or communities is expected.
- 59. PSSA consultants assessed social safeguard impacts in the sample five Pourashavas. It was reported the RBL program activities are unlikely to have significant adverse impacts. The potential impacts are short term and can easily be mitigated. Though it was mentioned in that there are few trees in the RoWs. But during visit of the social safeguard team in 2024, no trees were found in the RoWs in the Pourashavas. The team discussed with the community people about the reported trees. Nobody claimed ownership of any trees. All of these affected trees were under Pourashava ownership. The program has plantation policy to plant multiple number of saplings at the under-construction roadside in place of an affected tree.
- 60. During visits of social safeguard team, local people raised some problems due to construction works which required immediate solutions to avoid losses/ difficulties of the

people. The team had to solve the problem on the spot. The community expressed their satisfaction on the solution. These actions are being followed up and ensured by the safeguard team.

- 61. During visit to ongoing project at Modhupur, people showed their concerns that due to road construction works and in absence of water passing facilities there are water loggings for abnormally long time. The consultants advised contractor to arrange a cross pipe drain for easy passing of water from the area. In the next visit, consultants found that a cross-pipe drain has been arranged by the contractor and there is no water logging.
- 62. During visit at Naria Pourashava, it was found out that construction works of drainage is ongoing and contractor stacks construction materials in front of a hospital and some shops. The contractor was advised to shift the materials to appropriate place without delay. The contractor started shifting the construction materials in presence of the social safeguard monitoring team and shifted all of the construction materials.
- 63. The SSMR will be submitted to the ADB for their concurrence. After clearance from the ADB, this SSMR will be disclosed in ADB and LGED Website.

B. Recommendation

- (i) Social Safeguard Training should be started soon. Lack of proper training significant benefit from the GRM is not observed.
- (ii) Addressing of social safeguard compliances have to be monitored frequently on start-up-subprojects

Note: Out of 105 Packages in the table above, 104 packages were visited and social safeguard impacts on these packages were assessed during PPTA (Project Preparatory Technical Assistance) period of IUGIP. In this period, safeguard consultants found 4 temporary business persons will be affected at IUGIP/CHOW/UT+DR/01/2023 under Chowmuhani Pourashava. As their source of income would be affected due to project construction works, proper due diligence should be undertaken and accordingly, appropriate social safeguards document will be prepared. Among the five selected pourashavas for PSSA, Chowmuhani was one of the sample subprojects. During the reporting period, 4 subprojects were visited by Resettlement / social safeguard team of PMDSC of IUGIP and they screened the subprojects. The sub-projects are IUGIP/KALIA/ UT+DR/04/2023 under Kaliakoir Pourashava, IUGIP/MAZI/UY +DR/01/2023 and IUGIP/NAZI/UY +DR/02/2023 under Nazirhat Pourashava. Resettlement Specialists of PMDSC prepared three due diligence reports during the reporting period and submitted to PMU. As the Resettlement/ Social safeguard specialists received clearance for one DDR (IUGIP/KALIA/UT+DR/04/2023) from the PMU during the reporting period, information of only one number of impacts assessed subproject has been mentioned in the above table. After the reporting period, Resettlement/ Social safeguard specialist received clearance for the rest submitted DDRs. DDRs are submitted to PMU by the MDS Consultants. Disclosure of DDRs in the LGED/Project website is under process. The disclosure links will be provided in the next semi-annual social safeguard monitoring report.
